WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on October 14, 2005, also awarded a purchase order by signature list with Allied Electronics, Inc. for the purchase of equipment and parts on the same project, in an amount not to exceed \$9,203.10; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds for the purchase of equipment from both Rexel, Inc. and Allied Electronics, Inc., in a total amount of \$38,501.05; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the aforementioned purchase order with Rexel, Inc. and to appropriate funds, in a total amount of \$38,501.05 for the purchase of equipment from both Rexel, Inc. and Allied Electronics, Inc.; and
