21 22 23	WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and the Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement, to confirm the Study's cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of the Study; and

SECTION 2

The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

- a. That the parties estimate the Study's cost to be \$30,365.56;
- b. That LPA shall provide \$27,329.00 in Federal Safety funds with a local match of \$3,036.56 from the Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax fund;
- c. That County of Summit shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully complete the Study; and
- d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Study, with award of the Study subject to applicable County of Summit Ordinances, said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it completes a prerequisite to accept funds for necessary studies to further for safe and convenient travel within the County.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
