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SECTION 1

 The Court of Common Pleas- Juvenile Division is hereby authorized to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training and planning sessions and a volunteer recognition to be held in 2016. This Council hereby finds and determines that such expenses are for a valid public purpose.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing the Court of Common Pleas - Juvenile Division to make expenditures for hospitality items incurred in providing training and planning sessions and a volunteer recognition to be held in 2016.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
