A Resolution authorizing the County Engineer to establish the intersection of Flight Memorial Drive and Brookwall Drive (County Highway 538) in Copley Township, a four-way stop intersection, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Section 313.02(d) of the Summit County Codified Ordinances grants authority to County Council to erect stop signs, yield signs or traffic control signals at all streets and highways intersecting such through streets or highways, or may designate any intersection as a stop or yield intersection and shall erect like signs at one or more entrances to such intersection; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Flight Memorial Drive and Brookwall Drive, in Copley Township, in Council District 5, is currently a two-way stop intersection, with stop signs located on Flight Memorial Drive (for southbound traffic) and the access driveway (for northbound traffic); and

WHEREAS, both traffic volume and number of motor vehicle accidents at the intersection of Flight Memorial Parkway and Brookwall Drive exceed the minimum threshold determined by the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to install a multi-way stop at an intersection; and

WHEREAS, a High Capacity Software analysis shows under the existing two-way stop condition, motorists traveling northbound experience a delay of 34.1 seconds and motorists traveling southbound have a delay of 67.1 seconds, both exceeding the minimum delay of 30 seconds set by the Ohio Department of Transportation as the threshold for establishment of a four-way stop; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is in the best interest of the County of Summit to establish the intersection of Flight Memorial Drive and Brookwall Drive, located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, as a four-way stop;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The intersection of Flight Memorial Drive and Brookwall Drive, in Copley Township, in Council District 5, is hereby designated as a four-way stop, and the County Engineer is hereby directed, as soon as practicable, to place appropriate signs to change the intersection to a four-way stop consistent with this Resolution. Any law or regulation respecting operation of a vehicle at a four-way stop shall take effect immediately upon the placement of the signs at the intersection.
