A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of two) of a professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio to provide medical insurance coverage and administrative services for County employees and employees of certain other political subdivisions, under the County's self-funded insurance plan, for a one-year term, from 1/1/16 through 12/31/16, for an estimated total amount not to exceed \$950,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution Nos. 2009-472 and 2015-423, which authorize the County Executive to execute Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with any Summit County or Ohio political subdivisions that wish to participate in the County's Regionalization Program for County-sponsored health care programs; and

WHEREAS, Council previously adopted Amended Resolution No. 2013-359, which confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio to provide medical insurance coverage and administrative services for County employees and employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County, under the County's self-funded insurance plan, for a one-year term, from 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term; and

WHEREAS, at its November 18, 2015 meeting, the Board of Control awarded a renewal (second of two) of a professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio to provide medical insurance coverage and administrative services for County employees and employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County, under the County's self-funded insurance plan, for a one-year term, from 1/1/16 through 12/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$28.59 per employee per month for administrative services for an estimated total amount not to exceed \$950,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned renewal (second of two) of the professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately enter into said renewal (second of two) of a professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio so that the County has a provider of medical insurance coverage and administrative services for County employees under the County's self-funded insurance plan and for employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County is in place when the current term expires on 12/31/15.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
