A Resolution authorizing appropriation proceedings of property owned by Donald R. Hicks, needed for the improvement of the Bank Street Bridge (Akr-013-0047) over the Little Cuyahoga Bridge Improvement Project, located in the City of Akron, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a temporary easements of right-of-way are needed for the improvement by the replacement of the Bank Street bridge over the Little Cuyahoga River-SUM –CR13-0.47-Structure-AKR-013-0047 (herein the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the County despite negotiations, has been unable to acquire all of the right-of-way necessary for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and Donald R. Hicks are unable to agree upon the purchase price of right-of-way on property owned by Donald R. Hicks; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said right-of-way by court proceedings under the provisions of Section 5555.09 and Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code;

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the aforementioned appropriations proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The County of Summit hereby declares its intention to appropriate a Temporary (T-7) easement for highway purposes in the real property described by Exhibit A, attached hereto, said purposes to include the replacement of the bridge on Bank Street over the Little Cuyahoga, said property being owned by Donald R. Hicks (herein the "Owner"), located in the City of Akron, in Council District 2, and designated as Parcel T-7.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it promotes the Bank Street Bridge over the Little Cuyahoga Bridge Improvement Project, in the City of Akron, in Council District 2.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
