A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an amendment to a lease with		

A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an amendment to a lease with the Akron Area Arts Alliance to add additional space on the first floor of the Akron Center Building, located at 140 East Market Street, in the City of Akron, for a five-year term, from 10/1/13 through 9/30/18, for rent in the amount of \$1.00 annually, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit owns real property known as the Akron Center Building, located at 140 East Market Street, Akron, Ohio 44303, in Council District 4 (the "Building"); and

WHEREAS, the Akron Area Arts Alliance ("AAAA"), an Ohio nonprofit corporation, promotes art throughout the County through the housing of art galleries, offering a variety of arts programming and events, and hosting a creative business incubator; and

WHEREAS, AAAA wishes to increase their impact upon the community by increasing the space of their lease to allow for extended exhibition opportunities, expanded art education programming, provide more event and meeting space for arts organizations, and engage a more diverse audience throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-415, which authorized the County Executive to execute a renewal of a lease of County real property with the AAAA for approximately 32,678 square feet, for a five-year term, from 10/1/13 through 9/30/18, for rent in the amount of \$1.00 annually (the "Lease"); and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to further assist AAAA in continuing to provide these important services by amending the Lease to increase the leased space by increasing the leased space on the first floor of the Building, for a total of approximately 38,070 square feet, for same rent in the amount of \$1.00 annually; and

WHEREAS, because AAAA is a non-profit corporation and is leasing the space for educational and/or charitable purposes, the approval of the Board of Control is not required pursuant to Section 177.17(e) of the Codified Ordinances of County of Summit; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned amendment to the Lease with the Akfon Area Arts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to a lease of County real property with AAAA to increase the leased space by additional space on the first floor of the Building, for a total of approximately 38,070 square feet throughout the Building, in Council District 4, for a five-year term, from 10/1/13 through 9/30/18, for rent in the amount of \$1.00 annually.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute a necessary amendment to the lease with AAAA for additional space on the first floor of the Akron Center Building for AAAA to increase the amount of programming.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
