A Resolution authorizing appropriation proceedings of property owned by Chapparell's Baton and Drum Corps, Inc., needed for the improvement of the Arlington Road Roadway and Traffic Signal Improvement Project, located in the townships of Coventry and Springfield, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, standard highway easements of right-of-way are needed for the improvement of the Arlington Road Roadway and Traffic Signal Improvement Project (herein the "Project"), in the townships of Coventry and Springfield, in Council District 8; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit, despite negotiations, has been unable to acquire all of the rights-of-way necessary for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and Chapparell's Baton and Drum Corps, Inc., are unable to agree upon the purchase price of right-of-way on property owned by Chapparell's Baton and Drum Corps, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said right-of-way by court proceedings under the provisions of Section 5555.09 and Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The County of Summit hereby declares its intention to appropriate a temporary (SH-31) easement for highway purposes in the real property described by Exhibit A, attached hereto, said purposes to include the improvement of South Arlington Road, said property being owned by Chapparell's Baton and Drum Corps, Inc. (herein the "Owner"), located in Coventry Township, in Council District 8, and designated as Parcel SH-31.

SECTION 2

The County Prosecutor is hereby directed to prepare and file on behalf of Summit County, Ohio, proceedings for appropriation, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, of said easement and temporary right-of-way.

SECTION 3

The County Engineer, through the County Fiscal Officer, is hereby authorized to draw by voucher upon the County of Summit and pay into the Court of Common Pleas at the time of the filing of a complaint for the appropriation of said parcels, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, a sum not to exceed \$850.00.
