WHEREAS, the IT Board has recommended to County Council that it enact new Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "County Information Technology Advisory Committee," to create a 7 member committee comprised of volunteer information technology business leaders to act as advisors to the IT Board to further its strategic direction, aid in the advancement of information technology and provide advice in critical information technology decisions; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to enact new Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as recommended by the IT Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit is hereby enacted as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

## **SECTION 2**

The Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately enacting new Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances to create the County Information Technology Advisory Committee to advise and assist the County Information Technology Board.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
