A Resolution appropriating carryover funds in multiple grant awards including the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program ("SCAAP"), Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants ("JAG"), the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Programs ("SHSP-LE"), and the Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program ("IECGP"), in the total amount of \$1,286,105.96 which includes \$18,000.00 in matching funds for State Fiscal Year 2010, for the Executive's Division of Public Safety-Justice Affairs, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State Fiscal Year 2007, 2008 and 2009 SCAAP awards which provide federal funding as reimbursement for local legitimate incarceration costs for undocumented criminal aliens were accepted and appropriated in R08-029, R09-200 and R09-432 have carryover balances; and

WHEREAS, the State Fiscal Year 2007 and 2008 SHSP-LE, a homeland security program focusing on providing funding for law enforcement and public safety communities to support terrorism prevention, were accepted and appropriated in awards including R06-097 and R09-389, and have carryover balances; and

WHEREAS, the State Fiscal Year 2007 and 2009 JAG federal funding awards through the City of Akron, to develop and enhance programs within the criminal justice system, were accepted and appropriated in awards including R06-097 and R09-389, and have carryover balances; and

WHEREAS, the State Fiscal Year 2009 Interoperable Emergency Communications ("IECGP") grant for federal funds of \$114,000.00 and requiring a 25% local cash match requirement on equipment purchases, was awarded to provide planning, training and exercise funds in support of initiatives to improve interoperable communications, was accepted in R09-422 and requires appropriation in 2010; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned carryover grant funds in the total amount \$1,286,105.96, which includes the \$18,000.00 local cash match funding;
