**A Resolution appropriating carryover funds in the total amount of \$120,087.26 for grants from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice, the Ohio Attorney General, and the Akron Community Foundation Women's Endowment Fund, for 2010, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, \$46,350.00 remains available in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ("ARRA") Violence Against Women Act ("VAWA") stimulus funded grant (R09-405) which ends 7/31/10, from Ohio Office of Criminal Justice, and includes an 25% in-kind match which will be identified in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, \$68,629.68 remains available in the Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") 09-10 Grant (R09-406) which ends 9/30/2010 from the Ohio Attorney General's Office, including the 25% cash-match which has been reserved in the Prosecutor's operating budget (R09-469); and

WHEREAS, funding remains available from awards granted by the Akron Community Foundation, for the Introduction to Criminal Justice and the Domestic Violence training programs (R09-044); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover grant funds in the total amount of \$120,087.26 for expenditures in 2010; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the appropriation of the aforementioned carryover grant funds are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
