WHEREAS, this grant will provided funds for activities within the County of Summit and will be used to better mitigate, prepare, respond and recover from an act of terrorism and other disasters; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the award from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency in the amount of \$485,788.19, with no local cash match requirement.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of accepting the State Fiscal Year 2009 SHSP grant allocation for Summit County.
