A Resolution awarding a purchase contract, subject to approval of the Board of Control, with ITT Waste and Wastewater Flygt Products for three new pumps, including installation, for Pump Station No. 51 owned and operated by the County of Summit through its Department of Environmental Services, as Best Practical Source, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the pumps at Pump Station No. 51, located near the intersection of Massillon Road and Boettler Road, in the City of Green, Council District 8, owned and operated by the County of Summit through the Executive's Department of Environmental Services ("DOES") are at the end of their useful lives and must be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio awarded the County of Summit \$90,000.00 in American Recovery & Reinvestment Act funds toward the replacement of said pumps; and

WHEREAS, County Council has previously authorized the Executive to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan, in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.00 to finance the balance of the purchase and installation of new pumps for Pump Station No. 51 owned and operated by the County of Summit through DOES in Resolution No. 2009-341; and

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned purchase order is necessary and in the best interests of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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A purchase contract is hereby awarded, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to ITT Waste and Wastewater Flygt Products for three waste water pumps, including installation, as Best Practical Source, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, for the further purpose of immediately replacing old pumps at Pump Station No. 51, and to insure timely receipt of an award of approximately \$90,000.00 from an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 grant to fund the purchase.
