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7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into an agreement with the City of**
8 **Columbus to license its GreenSpot Program website, at no cost to the County, for the**
9 **Executive and Council, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the City of Columbus is the owner of a certain website and associated
12 intellectual property known as the GreenSpot Program Website, which promotes eco-friendly
13 practices and provides the public with information on environmental conservation; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Green Policy Task Force has identified the need for
16 the County to implement an informative website similar to the GreenSpot Program Website for
17 use by County residents and businesses; and

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19 WHEREAS, rather than expend the money and/or labor to design a new site from the
20 beginning, the County is able to contract with the City of Columbus to license the GreenSpot
21 Program Website, including such items as the design, format and layout, at no cost to the
22 County; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the
25 County to authorize the Executive to enter into an agreement with the City of Columbus to
26 license the GreenSpot Program Website.

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
29 State of Ohio, that:

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the City of Columbus
34 to license the GreenSpot Program Website, in a form substantially similar to the agreement
35 attached hereto as Exhibit A.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
40 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately obtain
41 the licensee rights to the GreenSpot Program Website and begin implementation of the site for
42 the County.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
48 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
