The membership shall be appointed by the Executive and confirmed by Council. The AVP Planning Committee shall be in existence until dissolved by Resolution of Council.		
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SECTION 2

The purpose of the AVP Planning Committee shall be for the purpose of:

- 1) Continuing discussions regarding the feasibility of implementation of the AVP Task Force's recommended goals and strategies
- 2) Overseeing the implementation of the AVP Task Force's recommended goals and strategies.
- Making regular progress reports on the status of implementation of the goals and strategies to the Summit County Council's Long Term Planning Committee in collaboration with the Summit County Executive.

SECTION 3

The membership of the AVP Planning Committee shall be appointed by the Executive and shall consist of not less than twelve (12) members. An alternate representative from any office or entity named to the AVP Planning Committee may also be appointed by the Summit County Executive to attend and participate in Committee meetings, discussions, and other business.

- 1) Summit County Council;
- 2) Summit County Executive Office;
- 3) Summit County Fiscal Office;
- 4) Summit County Health District;
- 5) Summit County Office of Consumer Affairs;
- 6) Summit County Court of Common Pleas;
- 7) Summit County Clerk of Courts Office;
- 8) City of Akron, Mayor;
- 9) Summit County Sheriff Office:
- 10) A Judge of a Municipal Court located within Summit County
- 11) A Mayor of a municipality other than the City of Akron located within Summit County
- 12) A trustee of a township located within Summit County
- 13) Up to three (3) such other individuals that are necessary to provide balanced advice on the recommended goals and strategies.

The number of members of the AVP Planning Committee may be increased as deemed necessary by the majority vote of Council. Any additional members shall also be appointed by the Executive and confirmed by Council.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose to provide an AVP Planning Committee to oversee the implementation or feasibility of implementation of the recommended goals and strategies.

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SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
