A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District to allow the District to hire a full-time Metropolitan Medical Response System Coordinator for calendar year 2010 to support the medical community and first responders of Summit County with planning, equipment and training, in an amount not to exceed \$43,398.14, for the Executive's Department of Law-Public Safety Division, Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2010-006, which appropriated carryover funds in multiple grant awards including the Metropolitan Medical Response System ("MMRS") Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2007-192 and 2008-014, the County of Summit used a private contract to act as an MMRS Coordinator, supports the medical community and first responders of Summit County with planning, equipment and training; and

WHEREAS, for calendar year 2010, the County wishes to provide a grant to the Summit County Combined General Health District to allow the District to hire a full-time MMRS Coordinator, in in an amount not to exceed \$43,398.14; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned grant agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District:

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, to allow the District to hire a full-time Metropolitan Medical Response System ("MMRS") Coordinator for calendar year 2010 to support the medical community and first responders of Summit County with planning, equipment and training, in an amount not to exceed \$43,398.14. The Grant Agreement is approved with changes therein not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County which shall be approved by the County Executive; provide that the approval of those changes by the County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the Grant Agreement.
