A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an amendment to a grant agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District, to provide additional funds, in the amount of \$34,800.00, to be paid from the 2008 Homeland Security Grant (State Fiscal Year 2007 State Homeland Security Grant), for the purchase of one gas generator to serve as an emergency power source for the District for its Graham Road offices in Cuyahoga Falls, in Council District 2, for a total amount of \$59,800.00 for the gas generator and a total grant amount not to exceed \$91,300.00, and appropriating the additional grant funds, for the Executive's Department of Law – Public Safety Division, Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2008-459, which authorized the County Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District, for an amount not to exceed \$56,500.00, to be paid from the 2008 Homeland Security Grant (State Fiscal Year 2007 State Homeland Security Grant), for the purchase of one generator and 21 laptop computers; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to amend the aforementioned grant agreement, which provided \$25,000.00 to purchase one gas generator to serve as an emergency power source for the District for its Graham Road offices in Cuyahoga Falls, in Council District 2, to provide an additional \$34,800.00 towards the purchase of the gas generator, to be paid from the 2008 Homeland Security Grant, for a total of \$59,800.00 to purchase the gas generator and a total grant amount not to exceed \$91,300.00; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the additional grant funds; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute an amendment to the grant contract with the Summit County Combined General Health District for the aforementioned purpose and to appropriate the additional grant funds; and

SECTION 1

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an Amendment to a grant agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, to provide additional funds, in the amount of \$34,800.00, to be paid from the 2008 Homeland Security Grant (State Fiscal Year 2007 State Homeland Security Grant), for the purchase of one gas generator to serve as an emergency power source for the District for its Graham Road offices in Cuyahoga Falls, in Council District 2, for a total amount of \$59,800.00 for the gas generator and a total grant amount not to exceed \$91,300.00. The Amendment is approved with changes therein not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County which shall be approved by the County Executive; provide that the approval of those changes by the County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the Amendment.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute a necessary amendment to a grant agreement with the District and appropriate additional grant funds.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action. were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
