7 **A Resolution approving the new classification, classification specification and salary**
8 **schedule for the non-bargaining, classified position of HRC Administrator #90211 and**
9 **amending the 2010 Report on Staffing to add the position of HRC Administrator and**
10 **delete the position of Director of the HRC, for the Human Resource Commission and the**
11 **Executive's Department of Human Resources, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, County Council has the authority pursuant to Article III, Section 3.03 (10)
14 of the Charter of the County of Summit and Sections 169.08, 169.09, 169.10 and 169.11 of the
15 Codified Ordinances to establish classifications, classification specifications and pay/salary
16 schedules for all County employees; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Human Resource Commission has requested pursuant to Section 169.11
19 that the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the non-bargaining
20 classified position of HRC Administrator #90211 be approved; and

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22 WHEREAS, at its March 22, 2010 meeting, the Human Resource Commission approved
23 the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the aforementioned
24 position, as stated in Order 10-02, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully
25 restated; and

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27 WHEREAS, as a result of the approval of the new classification of HRC Administrator it
28 is necessary to amend the County of Summit 2010 Report on Staffing to add HRC Administrator
29 and delete Director of the HRC; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
32 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the new classification,
33 classification specification and salary schedule for the non-bargaining classified position of HRC
34 Administrator #90211 and to amend the 2010 Staff Report on Staffing to add the position of
35 HRC Administrator and delete the position of Director of the HRC;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
