WHEREAS, following said approval, the County has entered into an OJT agreement with Plus One Communications, and desires to enter into additional OJT agreements with additional employers, whereby those employers will be reimbursed for OJT experiences provided to newly hired employees; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the deadline for the expenditure of said funds from 6/30/10 to 6/30/11, to ensure that all of the funds allocated for the OJT program are committed and expended through the aforementioned OJT agreements; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute OJT agreements and any necessary amendments to OJT agreements with various employers for participation and reimbursement through the WIA OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, through 6/30/11;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute OJT agreements and any necessary amendments to OJT agreements with various employers for participation and reimbursement through the WIA OJT program, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 collectively, through 6/30/11. The Executive shall continue to provide to Council, on a monthly basis, a list of all employers receiving payments pursuant to those agreements, the amount of said payments and the dates that the payments are made. This Resolution shall supersede and amend the authority granted by this Council to the Executive in Resolution No. 2009-355.
