7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept the award of federal funds from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a**  
9 **Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2011 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant of \$66,959.00,**  
10 **with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$22,320.00, and State Victims Assistance Act**  
11 **("SVAA") grant, in the amount of \$3,470.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the**  
12 **period 10/1/10 through 9/30/11, and appropriating \$92,749.00 for expenditures through**  
13 **12/31/10, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the Summit County Prosecutor's Office has received an award from the  
16 State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a FFY 2011 VOCA grant in the amount of  
17 \$66,959.00, which has a 25% local cash match requirement of \$22,320.00, for a VOCA program  
18 total of \$89,279.00, for the period 10/1/10 through 9/30/11; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has received an award from the State of Ohio  
21 Attorney General's Office of a FFY 2011 SVAA grant, in the amount of \$3,470.00, with no local  
22 cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/10 through 9/30/11; and

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24 WHEREAS, the VOCA and SVAA are annual grants which support salary and benefits  
25 for two full-time staff who provide the advocacy services to crime victims in Summit County;  
26 and

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28 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office provides for the required VOCA grant match within  
29 their annual budget; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
32 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute  
33 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the State of Ohio  
34 Attorney General's Office, and to appropriate these grant funds;

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36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
