SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately expressing public concern and dismay about the potential closing of East Akron Post Office servicing the residents and the business community of zip code 44305.
