7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire**
9 **one external person into a part-time, non-bargaining unit, classified Student Helper**
10 **position, to work in the Domestic Violence Unit of the Criminal Division, to be funded in**
11 **full through a Domestic Violence Training grant from the Akron Community Foundation,**
12 **for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
15 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary
16 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
19 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
20 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
21 said employees; and

23 WHEREAS, due to separation through resignation, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for
24 the continued and effective operation of her office to be permitted to hire and fill a part-time
25 Student Helper position, which is an entry-level position within the Prosecutor's Office; and

27 WHEREAS, the Student Helper position will be funded in full through a Domestic
28 Violence Training grant from the Akron Community Foundation; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it
31 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor
32 to hire an external person into a part-time, non-bargaining unit, classified Student Helper
33 position;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
36 State of Ohio, that:

40 County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is
41 necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize the County
42 Prosecutor, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire an external person
43 into a part-time, non-bargaining unit, classified Student Helper position. The Student Helper
44 position will be funded in full through a Domestic Violence Training grant from the Akron
45 Community Foundation.

49 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
50 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
51 authorize the County Prosecutor to hire said individual in order to continue effectively
52 prosecuting cases and collect revenue for the County.
