A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire one external person into a part-time, non-bargaining unit, classified Student Helper position, to work in the Domestic Violence Unit of the Criminal Division, to be funded in full through a Domestic Violence Training grant from the Akron Community Foundation, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire said employees; and

WHEREAS, due to separation through resignation, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation of her office to be permitted to hire and fill a part-time Student Helper position, which is an entry-level position within the Prosecutor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Student Helper position will be funded in full through a Domestic Violence Training grant from the Akron Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire an external person into a part-time, non-bargaining unit, classified Student Helper position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize the County Prosecutor, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire an external person into a part-time, non-bargaining unit, classified Student Helper position. The Student Helper position will be funded in full through a Domestic Violence Training grant from the Akron Community Foundation.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County Prosecutor to hire said individual in order to continue effectively prosecuting cases and collect revenue for the County.
