A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an Agreement with the City of Cuyahoga Falls, setting forth the scope of duties, manner of performance and all essential terms and conditions whereby the County shall enforce Part Thirteen of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Building Code", which incorporates the 2006 Residential Code of Ohio and the 2007 Ohio Building Code, on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, in the interest of providing building regulations throughout the State of Ohio, has adopted the 2006 Residential Code of Ohio, which regulates residential structures, and the 2007 Ohio Building Code, which regulates non-residential structures, to provide uniform standards and requirements relating to the erection, construction, repair, alteration and maintenance of residential and non-residential buildings within the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Department of Building Standards, through Part Thirteen of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Building Code" (hereinafter "County Building Code") has adopted the residential and non-residential building regulations which incorporates both the 2006 Residential Code of Ohio and the 2007 Ohio Building Code; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Department of Building Standards has been certified by the State of Ohio Board of Building Standards to exercise enforcement, inspecting and permitting authority pursuant to the County Building Code on behalf of and within townships and certain municipalities throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls desires to enter into an Agreement with the County of Summit setting forth the scope of duties, manner of performance and all essential terms and conditions whereby the County Department of Building Standards shall enforce the County Building Code on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and whereby the County Department of Building Standards shall have authority to (i) accept and approve plans and specifications for residential and non-residential buildings, (ii) permit the erection, construction, repair and alteration of residential and non-residential buildings, (iii) inspect the erection, construction, repair and alteration of residential and non-residential buildings, (iv) enforce the provisions of the County Building Code as they pertain to residential and non-residential buildings, and

WHEREAS, on or about December 10, 2010, the City of Cuyahoga Falls enacted Ordinance No. 122-2010 which authorized the Mayor and/or Service Director of the City of Cuyahoga Falls to negotiate and execute an Agreement to authorize the County of Summit Department of Building Standards to enforce the County Building Code on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Ohio Board of Building Standards will grant the application of the City of Cuyahoga Falls for certification of the County of Summit Department of Building Standards pursuant to Section 3781.10(A) of the Ohio Revised Code to enforce the County Building Code, on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and to exercise all authority under Chapters 3781 and 3791 of the Ohio Revised Code on behalf of the City of Cuyahoga Falls effective on and after January 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, given the uniformity of both the residential and non-residential building codes throughout the State of Ohio with the adoption of the 2006 Residential Code of Ohio and the 2007 Ohio Building Code, it will improve governmental efficiency and economy to consolidate multiple governmental entities performing the same code enforcement functions within the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to enter into an Agreement with the City of Cuyahoga Falls whereby the County shall enforce the County Building Code on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a comprehensive Agreement with the City of Cuyahoga Falls setting forth the scope of duties, manner of performance and all essential terms and conditions whereby the County Department of Building Standards shall enforce the County Building Code on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and whereby the County of Summit Department of Building Standards shall have the authority to (i) accept and approve plans and specifications for residential and non-residential buildings; (ii) permit the erection, construction, repair and alteration of residential buildings; (iii) inspect the erection, construction, repair and alteration of residential and non-residential buildings and (iv) enforce the provisions of the County Building Code as they pertain to residential and non-residential buildings.

SECTION TWO

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it will immediately authorize the County Executive to execute said Agreement and allow the County of Summit Department of Building Standards to begin enforcement of the County Building Code on behalf of and within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Cuyahoga Falls on or before the certification date of January 1, 2011, as set by the Ohio Board of Building Standards.

SECTION THREE

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of the eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION FOUR
It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
