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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby finds and determines that the aforementioned damage to the residential correctional facility located at 222 Power Street, Akron, Ohio, and the need to repair the same as expeditiously as possible constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 177.03(a)(3).

SECTION 2

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As a result of the emergency circumstances, this Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to enter into an agreement for the repair of the facility, without complying with the competitive bidding procedures outlined in Chapter 177, provided, however, that the agreement shall be approved by the Board of Control, and the County Executive shall obtain three quotes for the work to be performed prior to submitting an agreement to the Board of Control for approval.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to allow for the expeditious repair of the aforementioned facility.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
