The County Executive will transfer the parcels by quitclaim deeds after building plans and costs estimates have been approved by the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development.

Habitat will convey to the County valid first liens on the parcels to secure completion of the construction of low to moderate income houses on the parcels. Upon written notice of the final building inspections and approval, the County will remove its liens from the parcels. Habitat agrees to adequately insure the properties and pay any taxes and assessments during the time of construction.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately allowing Habitat to commence submission of building plans and cost estimates for the construction on each Parcel as required by the Purchase Agreement.
