A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute the First Amendment to the Trust Agreement with the City of Hudson concerning approximately 427.901 acres of land and improvements (Parcel Nos. 3000571, 3009800 and 3000574) located at 996 Hines Hill Road in Hudson, Ohio, 44326, in Council District 3 (the "Property"), and to execute any other documents requested by Hudson concerning the Property pursuant to the Trust Agreement without further authorization by County Council, for the Executive's Department of Law, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2009-397, which authorized the County Executive to execute a Trust Agreement with the City of Hudson in order to accept legal title to approximately 427.901 acres of land and improvements (Parcel Nos. 3000571, 3009800 and 3000574) located at 996 Hines Hill Road in Hudson, Ohio, 44326, in Council District 3 (the "Property"), from the Cuyahoga County Board of Commissioners, and further authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to transfer said land and improvements to Hudson, including, but not limited to, a quit claim deed, upon revocation of the Trust Agreement by Hudson; and

WHEREAS, the Executive executed the Trust Agreement on 11/10/09 and took title to the Property as Trustee; and

WHEREAS, Hudson anticipates that certain activities will need to occur on portions of the Property in the near future and desires that a conservation easement be granted over certain portions of the Property to the Western Reserve Land Conservancy in the near future; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.01 of the Trust Agreement prohibits the Trustee from granting easements or leasing areas of the Property; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish the activities desired by Hudson, it is necessary to execute the First Amendment to the Trust Agreement to grant authority to the County, as Trustee, to grant certain easements to accommodate anticipated public improvements and to lease certain areas of the Property as soon as possible to accommodate certain activities upon and uses of the Property; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of further such requests by Hudson it is further necessary to authorize the Executive to execute any future documents requested by Hudson concerning the Property pursuant to the Trust Agreement without further authorization by Council;
