WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff has three grants which end 9/30/11 with carryover balances from the Ohio Department of Public Safety/Ohio Traffic Safety Office, including \$86,302.99 in the Operating Vehicle Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force grant, \$10,296.00 in the Law Enforcement Liaison ("LEL") grant, and \$66,665.73 in the High Visibility Enforcement Overtime ("HVEO") grant; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff has a Drug Unit ("DLEF") grant with a carryover balance of \$10,733.98 and an extended ending date of 6/30/11 from the Ohio Department of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff has three federally funded Justice Assistance Grants ("JAG") from the City of Akron, with carryover balances, including \$4,028.52 in the Akron 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ("ARRA") grant, \$5,974.56 in the Byrne Memorial 2009 grant, and \$23,679.06 in the Byrne Memorial 2010 grant; and
