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7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement**
8 **between the Summit County Sheriff's Supervisors' Association, the Sheriff and the**
9 **Executive, for the period 1/1/11 though 12/31/13, for the Executive and the Sheriff, and**
10 **declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, a tentative collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the
13 Summit County Sheriff's Supervisors' Association, the Sheriff and the Executive, for the period
14 1/1/11 through 12/31/13; and

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16 WHEREAS, on 2/3/11, the Summit County Sheriff's Supervisors' Association ratified
17 the tentative collective bargaining agreement; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that the aforementioned tentative collective bargaining agreement is in the best interest of the
21 County and the Executive should be authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement
22 with the Summit County Sheriff's Supervisors' Association and the Sheriff for the period
23 1/1/11 through 12/31/13.

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
26 State of Ohio, that:

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement
31 between the Summit County Sheriff's Supervisors' Association, the Sheriff and the Executive,
32 for the period 1/1/11 though 12/31/13.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety
37 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
38 providing a timely collective bargaining agreement between the parties.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
43 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be
44 in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
49 the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
51 meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the
52 Ohio Revised Code.
