7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive, through the Executive's Department of**  
8 **Job and Family Services, to transfer an amount not to exceed \$483,461.00 in Temporary**  
9 **Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") Title XX funds to Summit County Children**  
10 **Services Board, and to execute any documents necessary to effectuate said transfer, for the**  
11 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") is  
14 the recipient of certain TANF Title XX funds, which it receives as part of its annual TANF  
15 allocation, and which reduces its annual TANF allocation by the amount set aside for  
16 TANF/Title XX; and  
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18 WHEREAS, on July 9, 2010, DJFS received an allocation notice from the State, whereby  
19 the State set forth the TANF allocations for DJFS for the time period of July 1, 2010 through  
20 September 30, 2011; and  
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22 WHEREAS, the July 9, 2010 allocation notice indicates that DJFS has been allocated  
23 TANF/Title XX funds in the amount of \$2,156,390.00 for the period of October 1, 2010 through  
24 September 30, 2011, said amount to be part of, and to be taken out of, DJFS' s TANF allocation  
25 from the State; and  
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27 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency ("CSEA") is currently  
28 facing a shortfall in funding as a result of the discontinuation of federal matching funds; and  
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30 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has provided an allocation of \$483,461.00 from the  
31 Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund to the Summit County  
32 Children Services Board ("CSB"), that can be utilized by CSEA to fund its ongoing operations;  
33 and  
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35 WHEREAS, CSB and CSEA intend to enter into a memorandum of understanding, or  
36 such similar document, in order for CSB to transfer the sum of \$483,461.00 from its Tobacco  
37 Use Prevention and Control Foundation Endowment Fund allocation to CSEA; and  
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39 WHEREAS, in order to keep CSB whole and to replenish the funds it is transferring to  
40 CSEA, it is necessary to transfer an amount not to exceed \$483,461.00 of TANF/Title XX funds  
41 from DJFS to CSB; and  
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43 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
44 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the transfer of an amount  
45 not to exceed \$483,461.00 of TANF/Title XX funds to CSB, and to authorize the executive to  
46 execute any documents necessary to effectuate said transfer;

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The County Executive, through the Department of Job and Family Services, is hereby  
7 authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$483,461.00 in TANF/Title XX funds to Summit  
8 County Children Services Board to be used for Non-Allocated Children's Services costs, and the  
9 County Executive is further authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate said  
10 transfer.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
15 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
16 authorize the transfer of said TANF/Title XX funds to CSB so that the corresponding funds may  
17 be transferred from CSB to CSEA.

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19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
