7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept additional funds and extended operating periods for two grant awards, the State**
9 **Fiscal Year (“SFY”) 2011 Workforce Investment Act (“WIA”) grant in the amount of**
10 **\$31,250.00, and the SFY 2011 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (“TANF”) grant**
11 **in the amount of \$85,000.00, both awards with no local cash match requirement, from the**
12 **County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services (“SCDJFS”), and**
13 **appropriating these funds for program expenditures, for the period 7/1/11 through 9/30/11,**
14 **for the County of Summit Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, SCDJFS has awarded the Juvenile Court an extended operating period to
17 9/30/11, with additional funds of \$31,250.00, for the SFY 2011 WIA grant, which supports a
18 case manager working with youths committed to lengthy stays, to prepare them for their release,
19 and for their transition after release, and

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21 WHEREAS, SCDJFS has awarded the Juvenile Court an extended operating period to
22 9/30/11, with additional funds of \$85,000.00, for the SFY 2011 TANF Family Resource Grant,
23 which provides intensive case management services to at-risk youth and their families; and

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25 WHEREAS, the SFY 2011 WIA grant which was originally accepted and appropriated
26 in Resolution No. 2010-297, for the period ending 6/30/11, in the amount of \$125,000.00, will
27 now have a total contract award of \$156,250.00, and

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29 WHEREAS, the SFY 2011 TANF grant, which was originally accepted and appropriated
30 in Resolution No. 2010-259, for the period ending 6/30/11, in the amount of \$340,000.00, will
31 now have a total contract award of \$425,000.00 and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
34 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
35 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grants from SCDJFS, and to
36 appropriate these grant funds;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
39 of Ohio, that:

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43 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
44 additional funds and extended operating periods for two grant awards, the State Fiscal Year
45 (“SFY”) 2011 Workforce Investment Act (“WIA”) grant in the amount of \$31,250.00, and the
46 SFY 2011 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (“TANF”) grant in the amount of
47 \$85,000.00, both awards with no local cash match requirement, from the County of Summit
48 Department of Job and Family Services (“SCDJFS”), for the period 7/1/11 through 9/30/11.
