A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into various contracts, or extensions to existing contracts, with employers for participation in the Subsidized Employment Program, for the period of June 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011, utilizing formulary Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds to fund the agreements, in a collective amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") was previously awarded a certain Temporary Assistance for Needy Family ("TANF") allocation in the amount of \$556,292.00 by the State of Ohio to be used specifically for a Subsidized Employment Program ("SEP") during the period of November 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2010-042, this Council authorized the Executive to enter into various contracts with employers for participation in the SEP program and reimbursement of wages for employees hired thereunder, in a collective amount not to exceed \$556,292; and

WHEREAS, the State subsequently extended the timeframe to expend the aforementioned SEP allocation to May 31, 2011, and this Council, pursuant to Resolution No. 2011-020, authorized the extension of the timeframe to enter into SEP agreements with employers until May 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, although the State is not providing an additional allocation of SEP funding beyond the period of May 31, 2011, due to success of the program and the emphasis on using TANF funds for employment purposes from both the State and federal governments, DJFS desires to utilize a portion of its formulary TANF allocation, in the amount of \$150,000.00 to fund SEP agreements with employers for the period of June 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this Council, after reviewing all pertinent information, finds it necessary, and in the best interest of the County, to authorize the Executive to enter into various contracts, or extensions to existing contracts, with employers for participation in the SEP program for the period of June 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011, utilizing formulary TANF funds to fund the agreements, in a collective amount not to exceed \$150,000.00;
