A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to prepare and submit an application with the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") for a grant to be used to finance the cost of the Pump Station #6 Force Main Replacement Project Q-325-2 ("Project"), located in the City of Stow, Council District 3, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvements Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvement projects to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to apply for a grant from the OPWC to finance the cost of the Project, which will entail construction to replace 5,630 feet of deteriorating 20" ductile iron force main with 20" PVC force main, for a total cost of approximately \$1,400,000.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to apply for said funds and to authorize the execution of any necessary agreements and associated documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is authorized to prepare and submit an application and associated documents to the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") to obtain a grant to finance the Pump Station #6 Force Main Replacement Project Q-325-2 ("Project"), located in the City of Stow, Council District 3.

SECTION 2

The terms of said application and associated documents shall maximize the requested amount of State Issue 1 funds, with the remainder of the cost of the improvements to be borne by the County of Summit through the Executive's Department of Environmental Services Capital Improvements Program funding, with a total cost to the County estimated to be \$700,000.00.

SECTION 3

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This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow the County to apply for grant funds for a necessary improvement.
