16	WHEREAS, due to recent repairs and stabilization of the bridge, the Engineer concludes		
17	that the 22-ton load limitation should be removed from the Vanderhoof Road Bridge over the		
18	Tuscarawas River, Bridge number FRA-215-0290, located in the City of New Franklin, Council		
19	District 7; and		
20	WILLEDE AS the removed of a bridge load limit requires are and result of Scation 220 12 of		
21 22	WHEREAS, the removal of a bridge load limit requires amendment of Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

32	SECTION 1

34	Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridge		
35 36	Weight Limits," is amended as follows:		
37	"339.12 BRIDGE WEIGHT LIMITS.		
38	(a) No person shall operate any vehicle upon any of the following bridges, if such vehicle,		
39	the gross weight of which, exceeds the maximum load limit specified for each respective bridge:		
40	brook was given at winners, encourse the maximum road mine specified for each respective bridge.

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48	(b) The County Engineer shall place and maintain, at both ends of each respective bridge		
49	signs of substantial construction to conspicuously indicate the maximum weight limitations of		
50	vehicle and load as provided herein.		
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- (c) In addition to criminal prosecution for violation of this section, in case of any injury to any bridge by reason of the violation of the weight limitation, damages shall be recovered by civil action on behalf of the County.
- (d) Whoever violates any provision of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the second offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree."

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to amend Section 339.12 to immediately permit the return of a necessary bridge to full use.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
