41	Section 165.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Board of
42	Trustees; Members," is hereby amended as follows:

44 45	"165.02 BOARD OF TRUSTEES; MEMBERS. (a) All Trustees herein appointed shall be residents of Summit the County of Summit
46	(a) All Trustees herein appointed shall be residents of Summit the County of Summit, Ohio. The Summit- Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Board of Trustees shall have all
47	the powers and duties enumerated in Ohio R.C. Chapters 343 and 3734 of the Ohio Revised

Code, and shall consist of the following members:

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SECTION 1 (cont'd.)

- (1) Three (3) trustees appointed by the City of Akron, one (1) of whom shall be the Mayor of Akron;
- (2) Two (2) trustees appointed by the County of Summit, one (1) of whom shall be the County Executive;
- (3) One (1) trustee appointed by the Summit County Township Clerks Association Township Association of Summit County;
- (4) One (1) trustee representing the cities of Summit County excluding the City of Akron, appointed by the Summit County Mayor's Association;
- (5) One (1) trustee representing the villages of Summit County, appointed by the Summit County Mayor's Association;
- (6) The Health Directors of the Summit County Combined General Health District and the City of Akron; and
- (7) One (1) trustee chosen by the other ten (10) trustees who is not a public official.
- (b) Of the total number of Trustees appointed by the County of Summit, (Section 2(b), (f)) one (1) shall be a resident of the City of Akron."

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the county of Summit, Ohio, and for the further reason is that it is necessary in order to immediately amend Section 165.02 to change the reference to Summit County Township Clerks Association to Township Association of Summit County to reflect a name change and to make other minor non-substantive changes.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
