Whereas, the electors of Summit County amended the County Charter on November 8, 1988, to require that County Council apportion the County into eight (8) legislative districts based on the recurring Federal Census; and,

Whereas, Article III, Section 3.01.4 of the County Charter outlines the procedure County Council is to follow to apportion the County into eight (8) legislative districts; and,

Whereas, Section 3.01.4 of the County Charter requires that every district shall be of substantially equal population, compact and composed of contiguous territory and the district map attached hereto as <u>amended</u> Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference complies with this requirement; and,

Whereas, this reapportionment process needs to be completed in order to submit same to the Summit County Board of Elections within sufficient time for the Board to prepare for the County election in 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

### SECTION1

Summit County is hereby apportioned into eight (8) legislative districts corresponding to the district map marked attached hereto as <u>amended</u> Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

## **SECTION 2**

The requirements outlined in the Summit County Charter and all pertinent information have been complied with in deciding and establishing the lines for apportionment.

# **SECTION 3**

The apportionment outlined in the district map attached as <u>amended</u> Exhibit A will be first used for the Council district terms beginning January 1, 2013.
