A Resolution declaring the recent structural damage to Portage Lakes Drive between Cormany Road and Peach Drive located in Coventry Township to be an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and authorizing the County Executive to enter into contracts for the repair of Portage Lakes Drive without complying with the competitive bidding procedures of Chapter 177 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, in Council District 8, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2011, the heavy rainfall and flooding exacerbated structural damage to Portage Lakes Drive in Coventry Township; and

WHEREAS, the structural damage to Portage Lakes Drive includes a failed retaining wall, eroded berm, and failed eastern edge of pavement; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined the damage to Portage Lakes Drive a threat to public safety and has closed Portage Lakes Drive to two-way traffic until the appropriate repairs can be made; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has begun the process of repairing Portage Lakes Drive by installing a temporary traffic signal to allow for one-way alternating traffic patterns and by closing the roadway during business hours to allow public services employees to use heavy equipment and reconstruct the road; and

WHEREAS, it may be necessary for the County to engage a contractor for the repairs of the Portage Lakes Drive; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to repair the Portage Lakes Drive as quickly as possible; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit permits the County Executive to enter into agreements without following the competitive bidding process in times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that the damage to Portage Lakes Drive constitutes an emergency under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to enter into such agreements with contractors as he determines necessary to repair Portage Lakes Drive without having to comply with the competitive bidding process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

County Council hereby finds and determines that the aforementioned structural damage to Portage Lakes Drive located in Coventry Township constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

SECTION 2

As a result of the emergency circumstances, this Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to enter into contracts with contractors for the repair of Portage Lakes Drive, that is necessary as a result of the aforementioned structural damage, without complying with the competitive bidding procedures outlined in Chapter 177 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, provided, however, that the contract shall be approved by the Board of Control, and the County Engineer, where time permits, shall obtain three quotes for any work to be performed prior to entering into a contract for work.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to allow for the immediate repair of Portage Lakes Drive.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
