SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to close and repair Portage Lakes Drive between Cormany Road and Peach Drive, located in Coventry Township, in Council District 8, and install a temporary traffic signal to maintain one-way alternating traffic flows.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is in effect until the time that the roadway is stabilized and can be safely returned to two-way traffic.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further interest of immediately protecting motorists from a hazardous roadway on part of Portage Lakes Drive.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
