SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately amending Sections 169.01, 169.02, 169.03, 169.05, 169.06, 169.08, 169.14, 169.15, 169.20, 169.21, 169.22, 169.23, 169.24, 169.25, 169.27, 169.28, 169.29 and 169.30 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, repealing Section 169.19 of the Codified Ordinances and enacting new Sections 169.19, 169.31 and 169.32 of the Codified Ordinances in order to immediately implement a more efficient human resource system in the County.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4
