A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") loan agreement to finance the Pump Station #6 Force Main Replacement Project Q-325-2 ("Project"), Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$1,197,800.00, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services ("DOES"), and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Project will replace 4,100 feet of deteriorating 20" ductile iron force main sanitary sewer with 20" PVC force main sanitary sewer owned and operated by the County of Summit in the City of Stow; and

WHEREAS, Council has authorized bidding for the Project in Resolution No. 2011-351; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to apply for a WPCLF loan to finance the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the WPCLF requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

That the County Executive be and is hereby authorized to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") loan agreement, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority to finance the Pump Station #6 Force Main Replacement Project Q-325-2 ("Project"), located in Council District 3.

SECTION 2

42 43 It is estimated that the total cost of the Project will not exceed \$1,197,800.00. The interest rate for the 20-year loan shall not exceed 3.4 percent per year. The dedicated source of repayment will be the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund.
