A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an agreement with Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") whereby the Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases, in consideration of SCCS seeking federal financial participation under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act, 42 USCA 670-679c., of the Prosecutor's allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, SCCS is responsible for preventing child dependency and neglect within Summit County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 309 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Prosecutor serves as legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title IV-E of the Social Security Act., 42 USCA 670-679c., certain costs associated with the Prosecutor's representation of SCCS in dependency and neglect cases are allowable for federal financial participation; and

WHEREAS, the Executive, Prosecutor and SCCS desire to enter into an agreement whereby the Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases in consideration of SCCS seeking federal financial participation under Title IV-E of the Prosecutor's allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to enter into an agreement with SCCS whereby the Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases in consideration of SCCS seeking federal financial participation under Title IV-E of the Prosecutor's allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
