SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a Local Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for safety studies of Flight Memorial and Brookwall Roads in Copley Township, South Main Street and Killian Road in Coventry Township, and Olde Eight and East Highland Road in Northfield Center Township, PID No. 91537, located in Copley, Coventry and Northfield Center Townships, Council Districts 1 and 8.

SECTION 2

The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

- a. That the parties estimate the Project's cost to be \$30,000.00;
- b. That the net estimated cost to the County of Summit shall be an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00;
- c. That County shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully complete the Project; and
- d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence consultant selection activities for Project, with award of contract subject to applicable County of Summit Ordinances, said ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by this Council or Board of Control approval.

SECTION 3

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This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose that it is necessary to immediately authorize the Executive to execute the Local Public Agency agreement in order to complete safety studies of County roads in a timely manner.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
