WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the new investment policies for the County adopted by the Board should be approved and that section 179.05 should be amended for the aforementioned reason;

The investment policies for the County of Summit adopted by the Investment Advisory Board, dated October 31, 2011, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, are hereby approved.

### **SECTION 2**

Section 179.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Board Investment Policies Adopted," is hereby amended as follows:

# "179.05 BOARD INVESTMENT POLICIES ADOPTED.

The investment policies for the County of Summit adopted by the Investment Advisory Board effective April 15, 2009 October 31, 2011, now on file with the Clerk of Council are hereby adopted as the uniform policies for investment for the County and are made a part this chapter as if fully rewritten herein."

# **SECTION 3**

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately approve the new investment policies adopted by the Investment Advisory Board, which now authorize the County to purchase the obligations of political subdivisions located
