SECTION 2

Section 1307.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Plan Review Fees for Residential and Commercial/Non-Residential Structures; Topographic Site Plan Review," is hereby adopted and enacted as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, which is hereby incorporated as if fully rewritten herein.

SECTION 3

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately enact said revisions to the subject fees so that the County may immediately begin recovering its costs in performing said function and improving the services provided to applicants.

SECTION 4

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

INTRODUCED

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
