A Resolution authorizing a super blanket encumbrance, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to pay agencies in the communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula, Barberton, Boston Heights, Akron, Richfield, Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the Ohio Department of Public Safety to the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Task Force, in an amount not to exceed \$104,229.37, for the period 10/1/11 to 9/30/12, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety ("ODPS"), through the Governor's Highway Safety Office, offers funding for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicate ("OVI") Task Force program in the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff's Office has been awarded \$198,449.88, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/11 to 9/30/12, to create a countywide OVI Task Force program to conduct high visibility enforcement, public awareness, and education for alcohol-related crashes and traffic-related fatalities in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2011-424, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the OVI grant and appropriated the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all at its October 13, 2010 meeting, the Board of Control awarded a super blanket encumbrance to pay agencies in the communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula, Barberton, Boston Heights, Akron Richfield, Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the ODPS to the OVI Task Force, in an amount not to exceed \$104,229.37, to be paid out of OVI Task Force grant funds; and
