A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a renewal (2nd of 3) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, as a Best Practical Source, for inmate food services for the County of Summit Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/11 to 11/30/12, in an amount not to exceed \$740,000.00, and authorizing an additional two options to renew the contract for an additional one-year term, for five total options to renew, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2009-411, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control, of a purchase contract, after competitive bidding, with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC ("Aramark"), for inmate food services for the County of Summit Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/09 to 11/30/10, with three options to renew for an additional one-year term; and

WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2010-511, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of the renewal (1st of 3) of the aforementioned contact for an additional one-year term, from 12/1/10 to 11/30/11; and

WHEREAS, the first renewal of the aforementioned contract has expired; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.01(h)(4)D. of the Codified Ordinances defines Best Practical Source as a vendor that is able to continue providing services in an existing program and has developed a unique understanding of the technical aspects of the program such that the use of the vendor for the continuation of the program or project is the most expedient and cost effective decision for the County; and

WHEREAS, Aramark has provided inmate food services to the County since 2009 and has proposed a reduction in its pricing in 2012 in exchange for this Council authorizing two additional options to renew the contract for an additional one-year term, for five total options to renew; and

WHEREAS, Aramark's proposal represents the most expedient and cost effective decision for the County, particularly in the current difficult economic conditions that have led to the layoffs at the County Sheriff's Office and accordingly, the proposal meets the Section 177.01(h)(4)D.'s definition of Best Practical Source; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(7) exempts Best Practical Sources from competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Section 177.10(c) provides that competitively bid contracts may be renewed for up to five successive annual terms; and

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff wishes to renew the aforementioned contract as a Best Practical Source for an additional one-year term (2nd of 3), from 12/1/11 to 11/30/12, in an amount not to exceed \$740,000.00 and to authorize two additional options to renew the contract for an additional one-year term, for five total options to renew; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned renewal of a contract (2nd of 3) with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, as a Best Practical Source, for inmate food services for the County of Summit Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/11 to 11/30/12, in an amount not to exceed \$740,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a renewal (2nd of 3) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, as Best Practical Source, for inmate food services for the County of Summit Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/11 to 11/30/12, in an amount not to exceed \$740,000.00, and authorizing an additional two options to renew the contract for an additional one-year term, for five total options to renew. The meal prices during the term of the contract from 12/1/11 through 11/30/12 shall be as follows: \$0.894 (751+), \$0.913 (701-750), \$0.941 (651-700), \$0.972 (601-650), \$1.011 (500-600).

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary order for County to provide meals to inmates at the County Jail because the first renewal of the inmate food service contract has expired.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
