No person shall be hired in contradiction to the annually adopted Report. The Executive's Department of Human Resources shall verify as part of any personnel action that the

SECTION 1 (cont'd.)

hiring, promotion, transfer or demotion of a person into a position with the Fiscal Officer, Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, Engineer, Prosecutor, Sheriff, County Council, County Executive, Department of Internal Auditing, Human Resource Commission or Office of Consumer Affairs is consistent with the staffing levels set forth in the Report. For each other County department, office, agency, authority, board and commission, the human resource department overseeing that entity shall verify that the hiring, promotion, transfer or demotion of a person into a position is consistent with the staffing levels set forth in the Report.

Pursuant to Section 183.03, the Report shall be submitted by the Executive to Council on or before November 15th of each year with either the proposed temporary or permanent operating budget for the next fiscal year, and may be amended by Council prior to adoption. The Report shall not be used to subvert the requirements of Section 169.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit regarding layoffs and abolishment. Council may extend the deadline for the adoption of the Report on Staffing for a given calendar year, upon approval of 2/3 of the members of Council. In the event the deadline is extended, the Report on Staffing for the preceding year shall remain in effect until the adoption of the Report on Staffing for the new calendar year. ..."

SECTION 2

Provided this Ordinance is adopted with the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, the deadline for the Report on Staffing for calendar year 2012 is hereby extended until January 31, 2012. The 2011 Report on Staffing shall remain in effect until the 2012 Report on Staffing is adopted by Council.

SECTION 3

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County and to immediately extend said deadline prior to expiration of the same.

SECTION 4

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
