A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept two federal grant awards for the Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult Drug Court Program in the amount of \$1,275,000.00, and appropriating \$625,000.00 of these funds, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has awarded a Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMHSA") grant in the amount of \$975,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/12 through 9/29/15, which is subject to performance review, to the County of Summit, for the operation of a Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult Drug Court program; and

WHEREAS, this SAMHSA grant's first project period is from 9/30/12 through 9/29/13, in the amount of \$325,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has awarded a Bureau of Justice Assistance ("BJA") grant in the amount of \$300,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/15, to the County of Summit, for the operation of a Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult Drug Court program; and

WHEREAS, this joint award program is designed to assist in the implementation of comprehensive strategies for enhancing drug court capacity by bridging access to both criminal justice and substance abuse treatment funds; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the SAMHSA grant in the amount of \$975,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/12 through 9/29/15, and the BJA grant in the amount of \$300,000.00, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/15, with no local cash match requirement;
