7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control for the renewal (first of four) of**
8 **a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections**
9 **services, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$5,437,436.86,**
10 **for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of**
11 **Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, on August 4, 2011, the County of Summit solicited seven providers of
14 community corrections programs and advertised Requests for Proposals to provide day reporting,
15 driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial services and residential
16 community corrections services; and

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18 WHEREAS, on the deadline of September 2, 2011, Oriana House, Inc., was the only
19 provider to submit proposals; and

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21 WHEREAS, on October 25, 2011, the Criminal Justice Advisory Board voted to
22 recommend to the County Executive to continue with Oriana House, Inc., as the provider of the
23 aforementioned services at a seven percent cost reduction of the 2011 contract price, to which
24 Oriana House, Inc., agreed; and

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26 WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2011-501, which confirmed the
27 award by the Board of Control of the professional service contract to Oriana House, Inc., for day
28 reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial services and
29 residential community corrections programs, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in an
30 amount not to exceed \$5,320,118.46, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term,
31 with the cost of any renewal term to be equal to the increase in the Consumer Price Index or
32 three percent, whichever is less; and

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34 WHEREAS, on December 16, 2011, the Executive executed the aforementioned contract;
35 and

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37 WHEREAS, the County wishes to execute a renewal (first of four) of the professional
38 service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for day reporting, driver intervention, home
39 incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial services and residential community corrections
40 programs, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$5,437,436.86; and

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42 WHEREAS, on January 2, 2013, the Board of Control approved a professional service
43 contract to Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections services, subject to confirmation by
44 County Council; and

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46 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
47 that the renewal (first of four) of a community corrections service agreement with Oriana House,
48 Inc., is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of four) of a professional service
10 contract with Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections services, for the period 1/1/13
11 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$5,437,436.86, is hereby confirmed and the
12 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such renewal.

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14 SECTION 2

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16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
17 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately
18 providing community corrections services effective 1/1/13.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
24 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 SECTION 4

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28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
29 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
30 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
32 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
