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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the Jail Heating,**
8 **Ventilation and Air Conditioning Upgrade Project, in Council District 4, for an estimated**
9 **total cost not to exceed \$680,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Administrative**
10 **Services – Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the Jail Heating,
16 Ventilation and Air Conditioning Upgrade Project, in Council District 4, and

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18 WHEREAS, a copy of the specifications are on file in the office of the Clerk of Council;

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
23 advertise for bids for the aforementioned project;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that;

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the Jail Heating, Ventilation
31 and Air Conditioning Upgrade Project, in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost not to
32 exceed \$680,000.00.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
37 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
38 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the Jail Heating, Ventilation and Air
39 Conditioning Upgrade Project and in order to significantly reduce utility costs.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
